## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION (2019-20)**

- 1. First preference for admission to the course would be given to the domicile of M.P. In case of non-availability, candidates from outside M.P. may be considered.
- 2. Age of candidate should not be less than 17 years as on 31st Dec. of the year of admission.
- 3. Candidate must be medically fit. They will have to appear before a medical board constituted for this purpose by the medical college.
- 4. Candidates who are already in service will be required to apply through proper Channel along with N.O.C. from their employer.
- 5. Selection of the candidates will be based on the merit of the entrance examination and personal interview held by the institution.
- 6. List of selected candidates will be displayed on the notice board of the college, on the next day of the last interview.
- 7. All the Courses are full time. The candidate shall not register for any other degree/diploma along with Nursing Course. If found guilty, legal action will be taken against him.
