

## **ZERO TOLERANCE TO RAGGING**

### **ANTIRAGGING POLICES AND MEASURES**

We welcome you to Index Nursing College Indore, (M.P.) As we are all aware that “ragging” is any act, conduct of practice by which dominant power of senior student, former student or outsider, is brought to bear on student freshly enrolled or student who are in any way considered junior by other student and includes individual or collective acts or practices which involve physical or psychological assault or threat or use of force or wrongful confinement or restraint; and/or violate the status, dignity and honor of such students, and/or expose student to ridicule and contempt and affect their self esteem; and/or entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gesture and obscene behavior.

The ultimate objective of regulatory measures taken by our institution is to make our campus ragging free and zero tolerant to curb the menace of ragging.

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the campus of Index Nursing College Indore. Several adequate steps have been formulated as per the directive of Honourable Supreme Court of India, University Grants Commission, Indian Nursing Council New Delhi regulation,

2009 and notification from the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh, thereby attempting to root out ragging. The following measures have been abided by to fulfill the need of the hour:

1. The students are free to approach the members of the Anti ragging Committee.
2. The senior student are sensitized and counseled periodically and anti ragging poster competition is being conducted with cash awards for best posters.
3. Copies of the anti ragging I.N.C. regulation 2009 have been distributed to all students.
4. Copies of these measures and policies with detailed contacts of Anti ragging
5. Committee, are distributed to all students and parents.
6. Undertaking affidavits have been obtained from all students and their parents/guardians.
7. A complaint box has been installed in the office to cater to any problems that the students may have.
