Road, Indore 452008 Madhya Pradesh with intake capacity of 100 seats in Undergraduate Course (BHMS) for academic year 2024-25 regarding.

Sir.

Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has received an application for starting new Index Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Mayank Welfare Society, 104, Trishul Apartment, 5, Sanghi Colony, A.B. Road, Indore 452008 Madhya Pradesh for 100 seats of BHMS course for the academic year 2024-25.

- 2. After considering the report of inspection carried out by Medical Assessment and Rating Board on 14/05/2024 and 15/05/2024, the competent authority has decided to issue Letter of Intent to Start new Homoeopathic Medical College namely Index Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Mayank Welfare Society, 104, Trishul Apartment, 5, Sanghi Colony, A.B. Road, Indore 452008 Madhya Pradesh with 100 seats, under NCH Act 2020 and its relevant regulations from the academic session 2024-25 subject to the condition that following shortfalls shall be fulfilled before the inspection by Medical Assessment and Rating Board for issuance of Letter of Permission for the academic session 2024-25.
 - a) The College shall appoint full time teachers and Guest Faculties as per Minimum Standards Requirements and Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in 'Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospital) Regulations 2013, as amended up to 2019.
 - b) The College shall maintain genuinely functional hospital with required average number of patients in OPD and IPD with required bed occupancy etc.
 - c) IPD and OPD case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, Address, and Phone Numbers etc. Case record shall be with complete case history analysis, evaluation and repertorisation.
 - d) Diagnosis shall be written as per ICD 11 Criteria.
 - e) All OPD and IPD case record shall be made available for Academic purpose of students and follow up attendance of the patients.
 - The applicant shall fulfil all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely 'Establishment of New Medical College (opening of new higher course of study or training and increase of admission capacity by a medical college) Regulations 2011' (as amended up to 2018) and Homoeopathy (Degree Course) BHMS Regulations 1983, (as amended up to 2019), for considering issuance of letter of permission.
 - g) Aadhar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) shall be implemented within 30 days.

After considering the provisions of NCH Act,2020 and its relevant regulations permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Index Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Mayank Welfare Society, 104, Trishul Apartment, 5, Sanghi Colony, A.B. Road, Indore 452008 Madhya Pradesh with intake capacity of 100 seats for BHMS Course for the academic year 2024-2025.

All admissions in Under Graduate/Post Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

The college has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act, 2020 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed, has to be rectified within 30 days' time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance.
